Registered members of the public attended the AGM of the Uitzicht Neighbourhood Watch to elect a new committee after the current committee had resigned. Nico le Roux chaired the meeting.	

Introduction

ITEM	DISCUSSION POINTS / ACTION ITEMS
1.	Nico le Roux opened the meeting. No previous minutes were discussed in any form as minutes were never taken by outgoing committee.
2.	Morne Joseph gave a short talk on the importance of NHW's working alongside the Police and the valuable contribution of an effective and working organisation.
3.	Presentation was made on the importance of a NHW being correctly registered with SAPS, CFP and Department of Community Safety (DoCS) as this allows members of the NHW's to have access to training and equipment.
4.	Nico le Roux called on Daryn Wickham-Basson to present financials of the UNHW. Mr Wickham-Basson began his presentation by posing a question to the attending residents of what the meaning of a volunteer is. An elderly resident stood up on a point of order and requested that Mr Wickham-Basson not take a condescending and sarcastic tone in his presentation. At this point, Mr Wickham-Basson then stopped, failed to present the financial information to the residents and sat down.
5.	After the ruckus had stopped, Nico le Roux then announced that the scheduled election of the new committee would take place.
6.	Mr Le Roux then called on Brendon Atwell and Gavin Louw to address the residents and answer questions as the two members standing for election of Chairman. Mr Atwell presented his stance for the election of Chairman and answered three questions from the residents. Mr Louw then presented to the residents and after about five minutes, Mr Tyro Peacock then asked Mr Le Roux to intervene as the presentation was becoming too long winded. Mr Louw then also answered a question or two from the residents.
7.	Both parties were then asked to leave the venue so that the election process could take place.
8.	Mr Atwell and Mr Louw were then called back into the hall where Mr Le Roux announced that Mr Atwell had won the election and was put forward as the new Uitzicht Neighbourhood Watch Chairman.
9.	Nico le Roux then stated that both Tyro Peacock and Nicholas Georghiou would be Ops Managers to which the residents opposed stating that this was an election and not for Mr le Roux to decide who would be in what position. Mr Peacock was then elected by the attending residents as the new Ops Manager.
10.	Mr Le Roux then stated that both Cheronne van Rensburg and Sanell Tennant would be Secretaries after the two ladies had agreed to work together.
11.	Mr Morne Fouche was elected unopposed to the position of Treasurer
12.	The new committee was congratulated and Mr Le Roux called the meeting to a close.

It was a fiery meeting considering the uncertainty and secrecy surrounding the financial position of the UNHW, which was the reason behind the hastily organised AGM.
